We are now going to go talk to Jeff Cutchin and listen to his presentation about our Information Systems Management Program.

For our campus tour, you can look at the campus map provided to you in each of your folders. We are starting in this bldg which is the Richard L. Mason Bldg. It houses all administrative offices including the President and Dean, a few faculty offices, two computer labs, two classrooms and a student lounge.

The bldg. to your left is the University of Illinois Extension Center and the bldg. in front of you is the Foundation Hall. It is the newest added bldg. to the FCC campus.

This is the Adult Education bldg. which houses Family Literacy, GED testing and Job Placement. It used to be our campus library before our new library was built. The bldg. to your left is Student Services. It houses all the Advisors, Financial Aid and the Records and Billing Dept.

The bldg. closest to the old Wal-Mart and Five Brothers is the Classroom Bldg. West. It contains 7 classrooms and a few faculty offices. Since classes are currently in progress, we will next be going to the Learning Resource Center.

The Learning Resource Center is our newest built bldg. on campus. It houses our library, the Nursing Dept and four classrooms. We are going to exit out the back door to be closer to the Workforce Development Center.

The Workforce Development Center houses the Automotive and Electrical Distribution Departments as well as the Emergency Preparedness offices. Now let's go into our Automotive Lab and hear from Rodney Maxey who is our Automotive Service Technology instructor.
