Single Parents in Career and Technology Education: Getting There

Kaskaskia College would like to provide assistance for *single parents* in our career and technology programs.

For students who are single parents, assistance would be provided through supplemental funds for transportation and self-sufficiency needs (such as food and utilities).

Applications are available through the Financial Aid Office (Bob Tebbe) or the Perkins Office in the Success Center.

Preference for award recipients: single parent with 3.0 G.P.A. after the first semester to qualify for the award (will be distributed in the spring semester).

Documentation of single parent status will be required.

Secondary qualification will encompass those single parents with a 2.5 cumulative G.P.A. after the first semester. Awards will be given in the Spring 2006 semester. Fifteen \$100 awards will be given. If 15 students do not qualify under the primary and secondary guidelines, the awards will be divided equally among those who qualify.

Award recipients will be notified of how to request funds, what qualifies for assistance, and the procedure required for payment to occur. If more than 15 individuals qualify, the awards will be distributed on a first-come basis. Thus, early application submission is critical.

Bring applications to Stephanie Burgher in the Success Center with documentation of Single Parent status. Official deadline for applications is January 26th, 2007.
